### AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO GRANT AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT is entered into as of February 13, 2024, between the KINGSBURG HEALTHCARE DISTRICT ("KHD", "DISTRICT" or "GRANTOR") and the KINGSBURG ATHLETIC FOUNDATION ("KAF"), referred to as "GRANTEE," with reference to the following:

- A. WHEREAS, the DISTRICT approved a Grant Agreement ("Agreement") on or about August 9, 2023, for the DISTRICT to provide grant funding totaling ninety-six thousand nine hundred eleven U.S. dollars (\$96,911.00 USD) for the installation of certain improvements and related equipment and facilities at the Crandell Swim Complex ("Program") located on the campus of the Kingsburg High School;
- B. WHEREAS, at its February 13, 2024 Board meeting, the DISTRICT's governing Board of Directors ("**Board**") considered a request from the GRANTEE to use a portion of the remaining unspent balance of Grant Funds, not to exceed up to **five thousand five hundred U.S. dollars** (\$5,500.00 USD), which were not expended due to a cost savings realized on certain items which were funded under the grant Agreement; and
- C. WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend the terms of the grant funding which are within **EXHIBIT A** to the Agreement, to authorize use of a portion of the balance of unspent grant funds, to purchase certain equipment and installation services related to the other grant funded equipment for Program use.

#### **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS AGREED:**

- 1. The terms of grant funding described within **EXHIBIT A** of the Agreement are hereby amended to read as provided within the new **EXHIBIT A** attached hereto and fully incorporated herein.
- 2. Except for the amendments expressly outlined herein to said grant Agreement, all other terms and conditions of said Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
