### **Item #1: Call to Order and Roll Call**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Thompson at 4:00 p.m. There was a quorum to conduct business.

### **Item #5: Presentation by Roxanne Marshall with ESYN regarding grant proposal.**

Roxanne Marshall with the Kingsburg area ESYN gave a presentation on their grant request for registration fees for Kingsburg residents, along with equipment needs, health-focused foods, and

community events adapted for these residents, such as egg hunts, carnivals, and breakfast with Santa. She expressed gratitude for the funds provided by the district two years ago for ESYN.

**Item #6: Presentation by Cyndee Gutierrez with Safe Harbor Homes and Services regarding grant proposal.**

Bill Matthews with Safe Harbor Homes and Services gave a presentation on requested funds through a grant to repurpose a garage at the facility to serve underserved adults with special needs. They would be hosting outreach services at the facility where parents can bring their special needs children. He asked for half of the start-up costs.

**Item #7: Presentation by Valerie Scott with Kingsburg Youth Soccer League regarding grant proposal.**

Valerie Scott with Kingsburg Youth Soccer League gave a presentation on grant request for AEDs for the soccer league to have access to during practice and games. This is a safety precaution that they would like to have and house on site at both Rafer and Reagan.

**Item #8: Presentation by Chief Stephens with the Kingsburg Police Department regarding grant proposal.**

Chief Stephens with KPD gave a presentation on their grant request to help with mental health exams for employees and families, and provide mental health crisis support to officers and their families. Chief shared some examples of how having this has helped staff, and they were able to get immediate help.

**Item #9: Presentation by Chief Roberts with the Kingsburg Fire Department regarding grant proposal.**

Chief Roberts with KFD gave a presentation on the department's grant request for funds to replace the gurney that is no longer able to be used since the ambulance rollover took place last year. The ambulance involved in the accident was repaired and has been brought back, and replacing the gurney is the last step.

**Item #10: Presentation by Adam Castaneda with Kingsburg Senior Center regarding grant proposal.**

Adam Castaneda with Kingsburg Senior Center gave a presentation on the City's grant request for funds to continue the lunch program at the Senior Center. The money will cover the cost of supplies and food, and the City of Kingsburg will cover the remaining cost for this program.

**Item #11: Presentation by Laura North with KESD Expanded Learning Program regarding grant proposal.**

Laura North presented on behalf of the Expanded Learning Program, her grant request which will serve 500 kids for the Summer School program. She requested funds for swim lessons and You

Matter Day. You Matter Day is where 2000-3000 community members come together to prepare items for the needs within the community. They will be providing 300 boxes to KCAPS and the Senior Center. Swim lessons will be for TK-3 and 4<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> graders during the Summer School program.
