1. Basketballs

a. **Project Overview**

Almost everything that is organized for basketball in Kingsburg is run through our basketball program. We have our Kingsburg High School basketball teams (Frosh, JV, and Varsity - 45 players total) with a season from November-February. We also run the Kingsburg Youth Basketball League for K-8th grade boys and girls from January-February (420 players total), and we run a competitive AAU program called Kingsburg Green Tide for 3rd-8th grade boys from March-May and for 9th-12th grade boys in June and September-October (100-120 players total).

That is all to say we use a lot of basketballs, and we use them a lot.

We try to order 8-12 new basketballs for our high school teams each season, 3 new basketballs for each AAU team (6 teams, so 18 new basketballs total), and around 20-30 new basketballs for KYBL each year.

b. **Project Cost: \$2100 each year**

- i. High School Basketballs - New Wilson Evo NXT Official Basketballs are \$124.95 each. (\$999.60 total minus tax)
- ii. AAU Basketballs - New Wilson NCAA Replica are \$49.95 each (\$899.10 total minus tax)
- iii. KYBL Basketballs - New rubber basketballs are 12 for \$95.99 (\$191.98 total minus tax)

- c. **Previous & Current Funding Source:** To be honest, in the past, we have waited too long to get new basketballs. When we have bought new basketballs, it is with fundraising money from KYBL or money from our school ASB account, but with the price of gear, refs and tournament fees going up, we have less money for new basketballs.

2. Uniforms

a. **Project Overview:**

Our school gives us some money that is supposed to help with new uniforms, but this money really only covers tournament fees for our high school basketball teams. The rest of our costs must be fundraised by our program throughout the year or additional money asked from parents. A big fundraiser for us is our Kingsburg Youth Basketball League. This league is run entirely by our high school coaches and players. This youth league is for K-8th grade boys and girls that live in or near Kingsburg.

Probably the biggest cost we have each year is for uniforms. Our high school

team orders new uniforms every two seasons. Our varsity uniforms get hand-me-downed to our JV team, and our JV uniforms get hand-me-downed to our Frosh team. Ideally we would be able to purchase new (cheaper than our Varsity uniforms) Frosh jerseys every 2 years as well, so they are not wearing 6 year old jerseys at any point. It works well for our JV to use the 3-4 year old Varsity jerseys.

We also buy other jerseys as well: practice jerseys for each high school basketball player, Green Tide AAU jerseys for our travel teams (3rd-8th grade teams), and KYBL jerseys for our youth league (3rd-8th graders get the KYBL jersey).

All of these jerseys are a major cost.

- b. Project Cost: Average cost per year over two-year cycle: \$6,500 minus tax**
 - i. New Varsity Jerseys (every two years): \$5,500 total for two sets of jerseys (home and away)
 - ii. New Frosh Jerseys (every two years): \$2,500 for two sets of jerseys (home and away)
 - iii. High School Practice Jerseys: \$2,000 for 50 practice jerseys
 - iv. Green Tide AAU Jerseys: \$3,200 for 72 Green Tide Jerseys

- c. Previous & Current Funding Source:** The last time we got new varsity jerseys, we were able to get a gracious donation from Stacked Restaurant in town. Our ASB school account gives us money each year for uniforms, but these funds don't even cover the cost of the tournaments we go to. We use the fundraising from KYBL, football snack bar, and other fundraisers we do throughout the year to save up for new jerseys. Our KYBL registration is able to cover the cost of our KYBL Jerseys and some of our practice jerseys.
