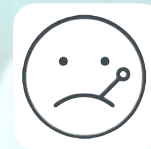
Symptoms

after exposure



Prevention

Wash your hands often with soap and
water.
Avoid close contact with people who are
sick.
Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or
mouth.
Clean and disinfect your surroundings
frequently.



If You're Sick

Wear a face mask.
Cover your coughs and sneezes.
Wash your hands often.
Monitor your symptoms.
Stay home except to get medical care.
Separate yourself from other people
and animals in your home.
Call ahead before visiting your doctor.

- Continuous Monitoring of On-Duty Personnel
- Increased Personal Protective Equipment Policies
- Strict Fire Station Disinfecting Procedures
- Strict Ambulance Disinfecting Procedures
- Strict Uniform Washing and Decontamination Procedures
- Personnel Quarantine Plan In Case of Crew Exposure
- Continuity of Operations Plan & Department Operations Center Completed & Activated
- Temporary Closure of Non-Essential Offices
- Limited Access to Fire Stations

What The City of Kingsburg & Your Local Fire Department Urge You To Do

- Stay Home Unless Gathering Essential Items or Checking on Loved Ones
- Wash Your Hands Often For At Least 20 Seconds With Soap & Water
- Avoid Touching Your Eyes, Hands, or Mouth With Unwashed Hands
- Maintain Social Distancing of At Least 6 Ft
- Clean & Disinfect Objects & Surfaces
- Avoid Shaking Hands
