1. Project Overview

Project Title: Kingsburg Behavioral Health Access Initiative

Reedley Community Hospital DBA Adventist Health Reedley respectfully requests \$89,241 to support a part-time licensed behavioral health provider dedicated to serving residents of the Kingsburg Healthcare District, at its Kingsburg rural health clinic for a twelve (12)- month period. This initiative represents Phase I expansion of Kingsburg-focused behavioral health capacity and is designed to increase timely access to mental health services for Kingsburg residents.

Currently, access to mental health services is limited within Kingsburg. In 2025, 260 different Kingsburg residents received behavioral health services through Adventist Health clinics located in neighboring communities:

- Selma Central Behavioral Health: 248
- Selma Behavioral Health: 8
- Sanger Behavioral Health: 4

Although these visits were in-network, all 260 residents were required to leave their community to receive care.

Six-month referral data from Kingsburg Rural Health Clinic (RHC) further demonstrates ongoing demand. During that period:

- 28 total behavioral health referrals
- 19 referrals remained in-network
- 9 referrals went out-of-network
- Resulting in a 32% unexpected out-of-network referral rate

Through this initiative, Adventist Health will add a **0.5 FTE Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT) or Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW)** serving 2–3 days per week (20–25 hours). The provider will deliver approximately **1,040–1,456 direct mental healthcare sessions annually** and is projected to serve between **130 and 200 Kingsburg residents** depending on level of care.

The licensed provider will serve children, adolescents, and adults ages five and older, with the majority of current referrals for youth ages eight and above. Services will address common behavioral health conditions such as depression, anxiety disorders, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), and other mood or behavioral concerns. Adult patients may also receive support for

more complex conditions, including personality-related disorders when clinically appropriate.

The Kingsburg RHC anticipates referrals not only from its primary care providers, but also from local schools and other medical providers within the community, including Kingsburg Joint Union School District. This integrated referral pathway will strengthen early identification and intervention for youth and families.

This project strengthens local health services by reducing travel burden, improving access to timely care, and expanding mental health support dedicated to residents of the Kingsburg Healthcare District.

2. Project Cost

The total cost of the Kingsburg Behavioral Health Access Initiative is **\$89,241**. Funding will support a part-time licensed behavioral health provider dedicated to serving Kingsburg residents.

Personnel expenses represent the primary investment of this initiative. Behavioral health services are labor-intensive and require licensed clinical professionals to provide safe, evidence-based psychotherapy services. The 0.5 FTE provider will deliver approximately 1,040–1,456 visits annually, serving an estimated 130–200 Kingsburg residents.

No capital expenses are requested. Services will be delivered within the existing licensed clinical space at Adventist Health’s Kingsburg Rural Health Clinic. No construction or facility modifications are required.

3. Partner(s)

This initiative will be implemented through coordinated collaboration within the Adventist Health care network to ensure seamless access to behavioral health services for District residents.

Key internal partners include:

- **Adventist Health Medical Office – Kingsburg Primary Care Providers**, who will identify patients in need of behavioral health services and coordinate warm hand-offs and referrals.
- **Adventist Health Behavioral Health Referral Department**, which will manage scheduling and intake processes for both internal and external primary care referrals to ensure timely appointment access.

Although no external financial contributions are associated with this project, Adventist Health will provide substantial in-kind support, including:

- Clinical space at the Kingsburg Rural Health Clinic
- Operational oversight and supervision
- Referral coordination and care integration
- Scheduling, data tracking, and outcome reporting

This collaborative structure ensures efficient implementation, continuity of care, and sustainable integration of behavioral health services within the Kingsburg primary care setting.

4. Funding Sources (Past 5 Years)

Adventist Health is a nonprofit healthcare system supported through operational revenue, Community Benefit investment, and philanthropic and grant funding. Over the past five years, the lead applicant, Adventist Health Reedley, has received the following funding:

5. Community Need

Mental health remains a significant concern within the Central California service area. Kingsburg itself is federally designated as a Mental Health Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) with a score of 17. HPSA scores range from 0 to 25, with higher scores indicating greater provider shortages. A score of 17 reflects a significant shortage of licensed mental health professionals relative to community need and reinforces the urgency of expanding local behavioral health capacity. Communities with higher HPSA scores often experience longer wait times for appointments, limited specialty services, and increased reliance on emergency departments for behavioral health crises.

The majority of patients served at the Kingsburg clinic are Medicare and Medi-Cal beneficiaries, reflecting the community's reliance on publicly funded healthcare programs. Strengthening local behavioral health capacity will ensure these residents, including seniors, low-income families, and uninsured individuals, can access timely mental health services within their own community.

Moreover, according to Adventist Health's 2025 Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA), 19.6% of adults report experiencing poor mental health, defined as 14 or more days in the past month when their mental health was 'not good.' Among Medicare fee-for-service beneficiaries in the region, 30% have been diagnosed with a mental health or substance use condition.

Community members identified long waitlists and limited provider availability as major barriers to care. One survey participant shared that individuals in crisis may need to call 911 due to delays in accessing outpatient services.

Kingsburg residents, specifically, are experiencing these challenges directly. In 2025, 260 different Kingsburg residents who were Adventist Health patients received behavioral health services outside of their community. Additionally, referral data shows a 32% unexpected out-of-network referral rate, indicating capacity limitations.

Expanding Kingsburg-dedicated behavioral health capacity will improve timely access, support early intervention, reduce reliance on emergency services, and strengthen the overall health and stability of Kingsburg families.

Reference is made to the information submitted for use in determining your status and that of your subordinate organizations for Federal income tax purposes.

The records of this office disclose that on February 20, 1936, you were held to be entitled to exemption from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101(6) of the Revenue Act of 1934 and corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.

It is the opinion of this office, based upon the evidence presented, that you, the churches listed in the S. D. A. Church Directory for United States and Canada and the subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions listed in the Seventh-day Adventist Yearbook 1949 submitted with an affidavit of your president dated December 5, 1949, are entitled to exemption from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101(6) of the Internal Revenue Code and corresponding provisions or prior revenue acts.

Accordingly, you, your churches and your subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions as listed will not be required to file income tax returns so long as such subordinate organizations are owned, operated, supervised or controlled by you. Any such change should be reported immediately to this Bureau in order that its effect upon the exempt status may be determined.

Furthermore, under substantially identical authority contained in sections 1426 and 1607 of the Code and/or corresponding provisions of the Social Security Act, the employment taxes imposed by such statutes are not applicable to remuneration for services performed in your employ or in the employ of your churches, subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions listed so long as the conditions prescribed above for retention of an exempt status for income tax purposes are met.

Contributions made to you and to your churches, subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions listed are deductible by the donors in computing their taxable net income in the manner and to the extent provided by section 23 (o) and (q) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, and corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.

Bequests, legacies, devises or transfers, to or for your use and to or for the use of your churches, subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions listed are deductible in arriving at the value of the net estate of a decedent for estate tax purposes in the manner and to the extent provided by sections 812(d) and 861(a) (3) of the Code and/or corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts. Gifts of property to you and to your churches, subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions listed are deductible in computing net gifts for gift tax purposes in the manner and to the extent provided in section 1004(a) (2) (B) and 1004(b)(2) and (3) of the Code and/or corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.

You should furnish the Bureau annually on the calendar year basis lists, in triplicate, showing the names and addresses of any churches, subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations or institutions authorized by you during the year, and the names and addresses of any such organizations which, for any reason, have ceased to exist during the year. Such annual lists should be accompanied by a statement sworn to by one of your principal officers as to whether the information heretofore submitted by you, and on which this ruling is based, is applicable in all respects to the churches, subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions appearing on the lists, and should be forwarded so as to reach this office not later than February 15 of the following year.

The collectors of internal revenue for the districts in which you and your churches, subordinate divisions, conferences, other organizations and institutions are located are being advised of this action.

Sirs:

Reference is made to the evidence submitted by you in support of your claim to exemption from Federal income tax and also from the payment of the excise tax imposed by section 901 of the Social Security Act.

The evidence discloses that you are an unincorporated organization. Your object as set forth in your constitution is "to teach all nations the commandments of God and the everlasting gospel of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ." Section 1 of Article III of your constitution provides that your membership shall consist of such union conferences and union missions as have been or shall be properly organized and accepted by vote of the General Conference in session and such local conferences and properly organized missions not included in any union conference or in any union mission as have been or shall be properly organized and accepted by vote of the General Conference in session.

It is explained that your work is carried on through subsidiary organizations, including union and local conferences and missions, publishing houses, and educational and medical institutions; that your organization and its subsidiaries have been organized for the sole purpose of carrying on religious, educational and philanthropic work; that none of these organizations are operated for gain; that no dividends are ever declared or ever paid to any individual, all gains or profits being used or expended for religious, educational, benevolent, charitable and philanthropic work; and that while the denominational work of Seventh-day Adventists is carried on under many subsidiary organizations, all of these organizations head up in your organization and are related one to the other through your organization. It appears further that you prescribe the general policies relating to all business carried on in the name of your denomination; that you promulgate a wage scale covering the wages paid to various classes of workers in denominational employ; that you operate a sustentation plan for the benefit of disabled employees of conferences and institutions and for the support of their widows and orphans; and that transfers of workers from one subsidiary organization to another are effected through you. Annual financial statements of the organizations and institutions connected with the Seventh-day Adventist denomination are issued by you.

Based upon the facts presented, it is held that you are entitled to exemption under the provisions of section 101 (6) of the Revenue Act of 1934 and the corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts. You are not, therefore, required to file returns for 1934 and prior years, and future returns will not be required so long as there is no change in your organization, your purposes or method of operation.

Any changes in your form of organization or method of operation, as shown by the evidence submitted, must be immediately reported to the collector of internal revenue for your district, in order that the effect of such changes upon your present exempt status may be determined.

The exemption granted in this letter does not apply to taxes levied under other titles or provisions of the respective revenue acts, except insofar as exemption is granted expressly under those provisions to organizations enumerated in section 101 of the Revenue Act of 1934 and the corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.

Contributions to your organization by individual donors are deductible by such individuals in arriving at their taxable net income in the manner and to the extent provided by section 23 (o) of the Revenue Act of 1934 and the corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts. The deductibility of contributions by corporations is governed by sections 102 and 107 of the Revenue Act of 1935.

It is also held that you are exempt from the payment of the excise tax imposed by section 901 of the Social Security Act inasmuch as you come within the excepting provisions of section 907 (c) (7) of that Act.

8. Plans

Behavioral health services will be delivered within existing licensed clinical space at Adventist Health's Rural Health Clinic located at 1781 Simpson Street, Kingsburg, CA 93631. This facility (built in 2021) provides a professional, confidential, and accessible environment for in-person psychotherapy services.

The clinic has available capacity to designate an existing exam room for behavioral health visits. The space meets regulatory standards for patient privacy and safety and is already equipped to support outpatient clinical services. No construction, renovation, or facility modifications are required.

The proposed model allows for immediate implementation upon award and hiring of a 0.5 FTE behavioral health provider, utilizing established scheduling systems, clinical infrastructure, and operational support. This ensures efficient use of grant funds while maximizing direct service delivery to Kingsburg residents.
